We replace diesel-generated power in remote island schools with solar or wind alternatives. The money saved on fuel is spent on education. For example, Rabi Island High School now has constant power and diverts over \$7000 per year from fuel to books, software and other resources. That's a big deal considering the average family income is less than \$100 per month. The initiative will also save over 150 tonnes of carbon dioxide.

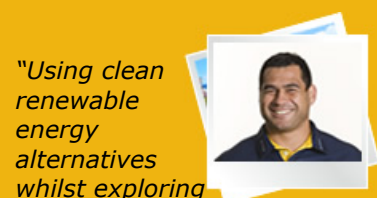
